The Futuro Health Mission

Futuro Health's mission is to increase the health and wealth of communities by growing the largest network of allied health workers in the nation, starting in California. We believe that investing in education and skills training and retraining results in better-paying jobs for workers, better care for patients, and better workers for employers to hire.



Our 2020-2021 Achievements

- **Pandemic-readiness training launched.** From the start of COVID-19 surges, we provided pandemic-readiness training for 4,000+ healthcare workers and first responders in 20 states.
- **Student enrollment goal surpassed.** We enrolled 3,500 adults into healthcare programs with our education partners. This brings the total to over 5,000 students served by Futuro Health since our launch in 2020.
- **Vaccination campaign launched.** Futuro Health provided nursing and allied health students an opportunity to gain clinical hours by joining the frontline battle against COVID-19. We delivered 25,000 staffing hours, 7,500 clinical hours, and played a role in administering 677,1000 vaccines in partnership with Kaiser Permanente, Adventist Health, the California Medical Association, and Dignity Health.
- **We're focusing on behavioral health.** Anticipating the pandemic's aftereffects on mental and behavioral health, we've developed three training offerings to grow the workforce: Community Health Worker with a Behavioral Health Emphasis, Care Coordinator with a Behavioral Health Emphasis, and Behavioral Health Microcredential to upskill existing credentialed healthcare workers.
- **We're connecting students and employers.** The new Futuro Health Job Marketplace, now available to Futuro Health students and alumni via their portal, is making it easier for students to connect with employers, and for employers to find and hire the qualified and diverse healthcare they need.
- **We embrace diversity.** We believe that diversity brings strength. And our diverse students go on to improve health within their communities, generating greater provider-to-patient trust.
