Ton-Quinlivan is author of best-seller book, <u>WorkforceRx: Inclusive and Agile Strategies for Employers, Educators and Workers During Unsettled Times</u> and a podcast host. She frequently shares her expertise on workforce development and innovation at state, national and global convenings, focusing on the intersection of policy, education, and economic growth, inspiring audiences to think critically about the future workforce of healthcare. Her most recent speaking engagements include the TIAA TMRW 2025 convening that brought together leaders from healthcare and higher education in Hollywood, Florida, and the ASU+GSV 2025 Summit in San Diego, California, which convenes the edtech community.
